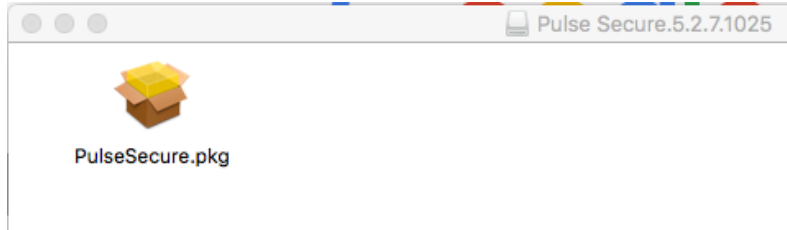


BFTV Pulse Secure VPN Instructions for Mac

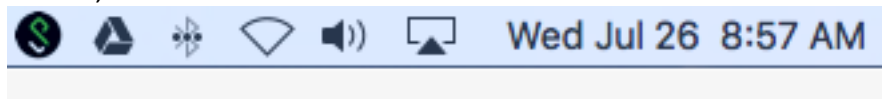
1. Download the appropriate VPN client for your Operating System from the [BFTV website](#). Click on Mac OS and then open the .dmg file that the browser downloads.
2. This window should appear. Double-click on the PulseSecure.pkg icon.



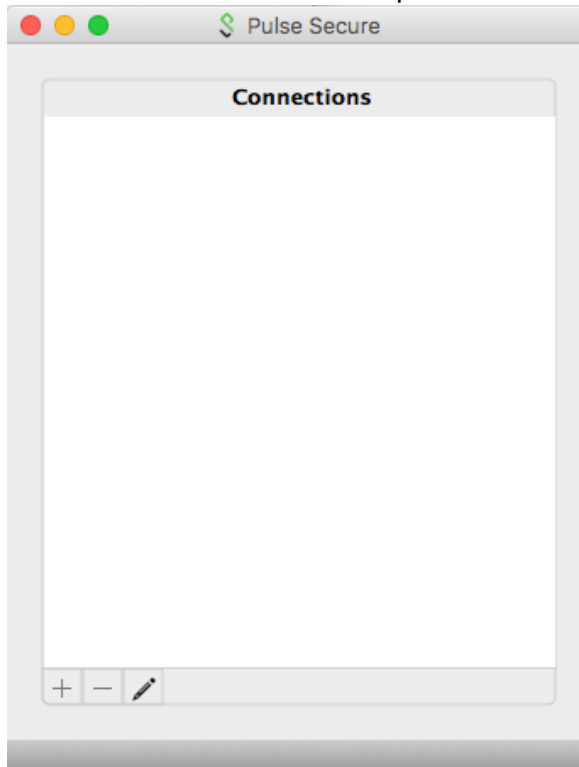
3. This window should appear. Follow the instructions to download Pulse Secure.



4. Once installed, click the Pulse Secure icon in the menu bar



5. Then click **Open Pulse Secure**. When the Pulse Secure windows appears, Click the + button to create a connection profile.

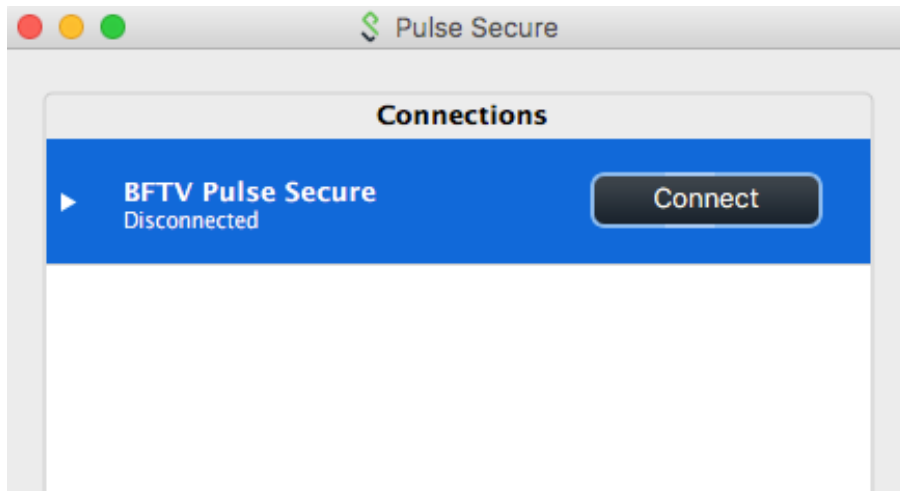


6. Leave the Type as **Policy Secure (UAC) or Connect Secure (VPN)**

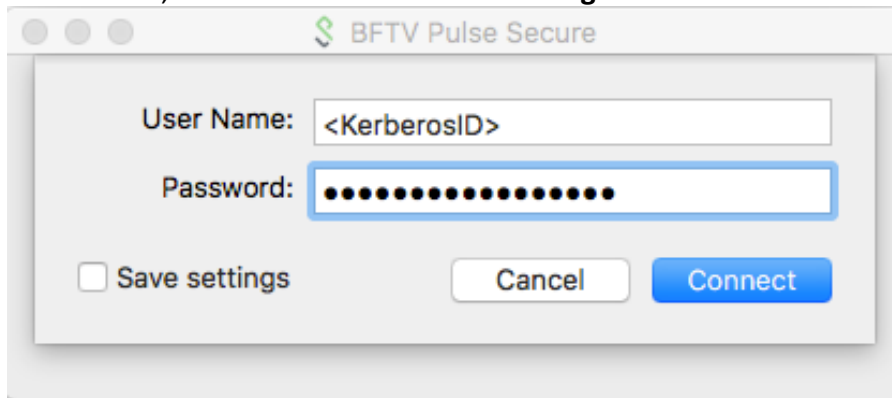

- a. Enter a name for Name, **BFTV Pulse Secure**
- b. For Server enter **bftv.vpn.ucdavis.edu**
- c. Click **Add**

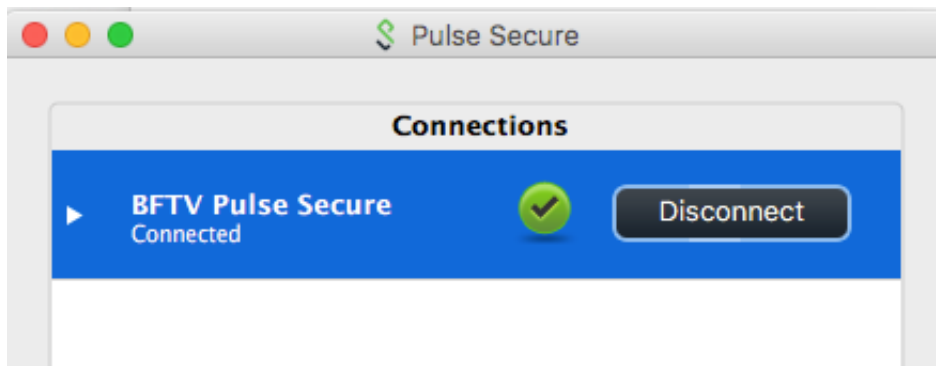
7. Then click **Connect**



8. Enter your Kerberos or CAS login and click **Connect**. If you wish to save your login information, make sure to check **Save settings**.



9. If successful, the Pulse Secure page should look like this. Congrats! You are now logged into the BFTV Pulse Secure VPN.



10. To disconnect from the BFTV Pulse Secure VPN, simply click the **Disconnect** button.
