

BFTV Pulse Secure VPN Instructions for Windows

1. Download the appropriate VPN client for your Operating System from the [BFTV website](#). Click on "Windows 32-bit" or "Windows 64-bit" depending on your operating system. Run the .msi file that the browser downloads.
2. This window should appear. Follow the instructions to install Pulse Secure.

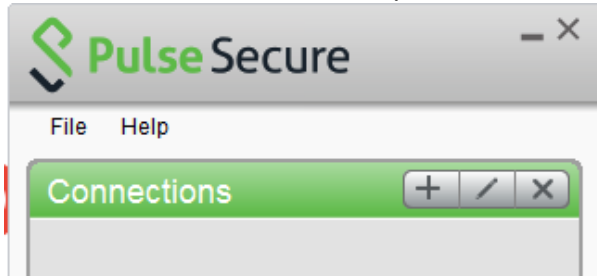


NOTE It should prompt you here if you downloaded the wrong bit version.

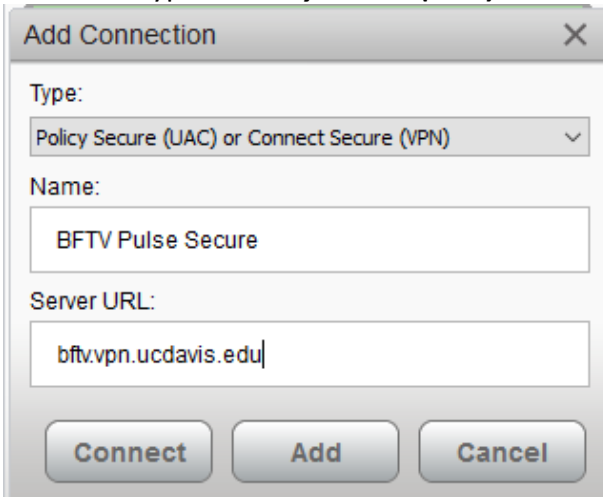
3. Once installed, click the arrow on the bottom right part (notifications) of your screen and right click Pulse Secure icon.



4. Then click **Open Pulse Secure**. When the Pulse Secure windows appears, Click the + button to create a connection profile.

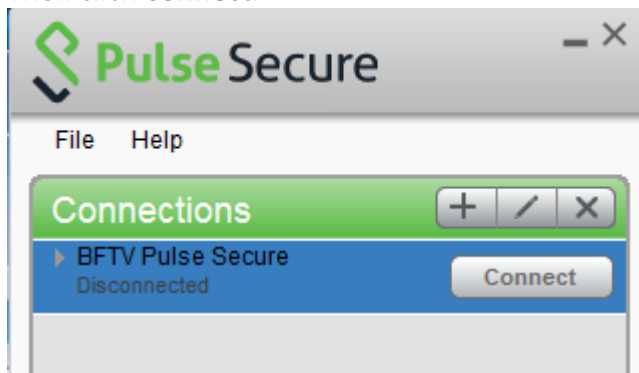


5. Leave the Type as **Policy Secure (UAC) or Connect Secure (VPN)**




- For Name, enter: **BFTV Pulse Secure**
- For Server, enter: **bftv.vpn.ucdavis.edu**
- Click **Add**

6. Then click **Connect**.

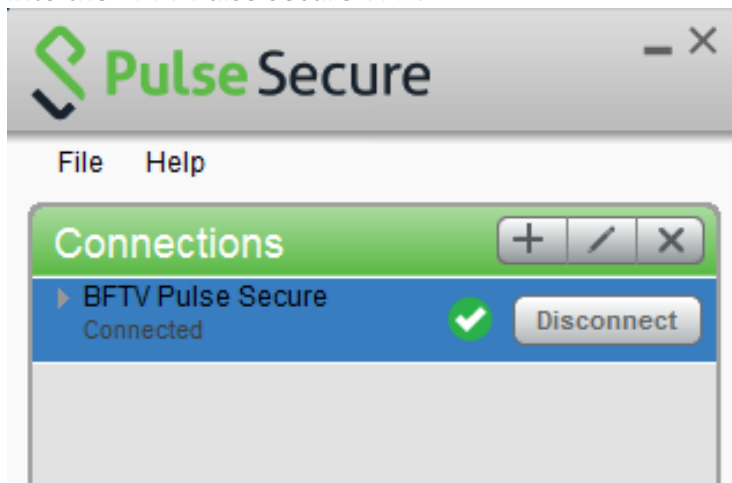


7. Enter your Kerberos or CAS login and click **Connect**. If you wish to save your login information, make sure to check **Save settings**.
